

Today's parable is The Good Samaritan

- \Rightarrow Only Luke records this parable.
- ⇒ The descent from Jerusalem, which lies 2700 feet above sea level, to Jericho, which lies 17 miles away about 800 feet below sea level, is more than 200 feet per mile.
- ⇒ The road from Jerusalem to Jericho is barren, hilly, with numerous hiding spots for bandits along this notoriously treacherous road.
- ⇒ Jews believed Samaritans to be people of doubtful descent and inadequate theology. They accepted only the Torah (the first five books of the OT) and argued that the true temple was on Mount Gerizim.
- ⇒ Samaritans and Jews had notoriously bad relations.
- ⇒ The two denarii given to the innkeeper would have provided room and board for about two weeks.
